MYOB Greentree Release Notes 2020.3.0



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Introduction

Release 2020.3.0 consists of enhancements to both Greentree Desktop and Greentree Browser.

Greentree Desktop includes enhancements and improvements aligned to the New Zealand Holidays Act. These enhancements make it easier for you to onboard employees who track days paid to calculate average daily pay.

This release also fixes bugs in Greentree Desktop and Greentree Browser, as well as in eDocs and WebView.

Enhancements – Greentree Desktop

Payroll Updates

Maximum Superannuation Contribution

The 2020-2021 maximum superannuation contribution amount has increased from 1 July 2020 to \$57,090.

Note: The SGC rate remains at 9.5% until 30 June 2021. It will increase by 0.5% each year until it reaches 12% by 1 July 2025.

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Interface Updates

Changes to Sorting, Filtering, and Moving Columns in Clever Tables

We've changed the way you sort, filter, and move columns in clever tables. Performing any of those actions is now more consistent across different types of tables in the application.

The icons in the column headings for sorting and filtering are now clearer – for example:

Updates to the Average Daily Pay Comparison Script

Additional selection criteria have been added to the Average Daily Pay Comparison Script:

- Results can be filtered by employee status.
- Results include negative quantity lines if the new Include negative quantity lines box is ticked (by default it is unticked by default, so only positive lines will be returned).

Updates to Populate Days Paid on Pay Script

This release adds two options to the Populate Days Paid on Pay script:

- Include HR Pay Journals This checkbox controls whether to include or exclude HR Pay Journals when updating the Std Days/Pay from an Employees Std Days/Pay. By default, this box is unticked, so any HR Pay Journals will not be updated.
- Update all pays in a pay period If this checkbox is ticked, all pays will be updated (this is the behaviour from previous releases). If it is unticked, the system will check for other pays in the period and update the pay that has the largest quantity of hours. (In the rare case of multiple pays with the same largest quantity in the same pay period, the first-entered pay with that quantity will be updated.)

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Enhancements – BPM

Printing Reports from Non-GUI Applications

HotPrinting of a report in BPM from non-GUI applications is now supported.

A new condition called "Application has user interface" is available for both BPM and A&A. This allows the user to control the logic execution based on whether the application has a user interface.

Bug Fixes

Greentree Desktop

We've fixed these issues in Greentree Desktop:

HR Leave Planning

• Leave Planning now applies View mode to the Leave Request Entry form and the Leave Requests Summary, Leave Requests Detail and Outstanding Leave Requests reports. The form now determines the Employees accessible according to the user's HR Privileges. The report parameter forms also show a Security View setting. This setting is used in combination with the user's HR Privileges to determine the Leave Requests shown in the reports. Existing saved selections for the reports will not show the Security View setting.

HR Payroll

• The STC template can now include Student loan type where an employee has a Tailored Tax code as well as a student loan.

Sales Orders

• When entering search criteria on the SO Release Backorders/Forward Orders form, selections in the **From** field now update the selection in the **To** field. This provides consistency with other forms.

Various Fixes

- If you generate a PDF of help annotations a nested exceptions error no longer occurs.
- Updates to the online help for the eDocs licencing limit warning functionality and correction of spelling error in the email sent when sites reach the specified warning limit.
- The User Interface has been updated for the Install wizard to reflect the desktop User Interface.
- The Install Wizard has been changed to update the shortcuts and batch files to use the 64 bit bin.
- When the HR System Control is reinitialised, the release prevents the setting on the Mobile timesheet control from being reset.

eDocs

We've fixed these issues in eDocs:

• This release prevents a null object reference error when an eDoc with no header is recalled. Header information can be entered for the document or the document can be deleted.

WebView

We've fixed these issues in WebView:

• A fault that blocked access to WebView report libraries has been fixed. Users can no longer delete report forms that have associated published reports. The fix includes removal of orphaned published reports.
