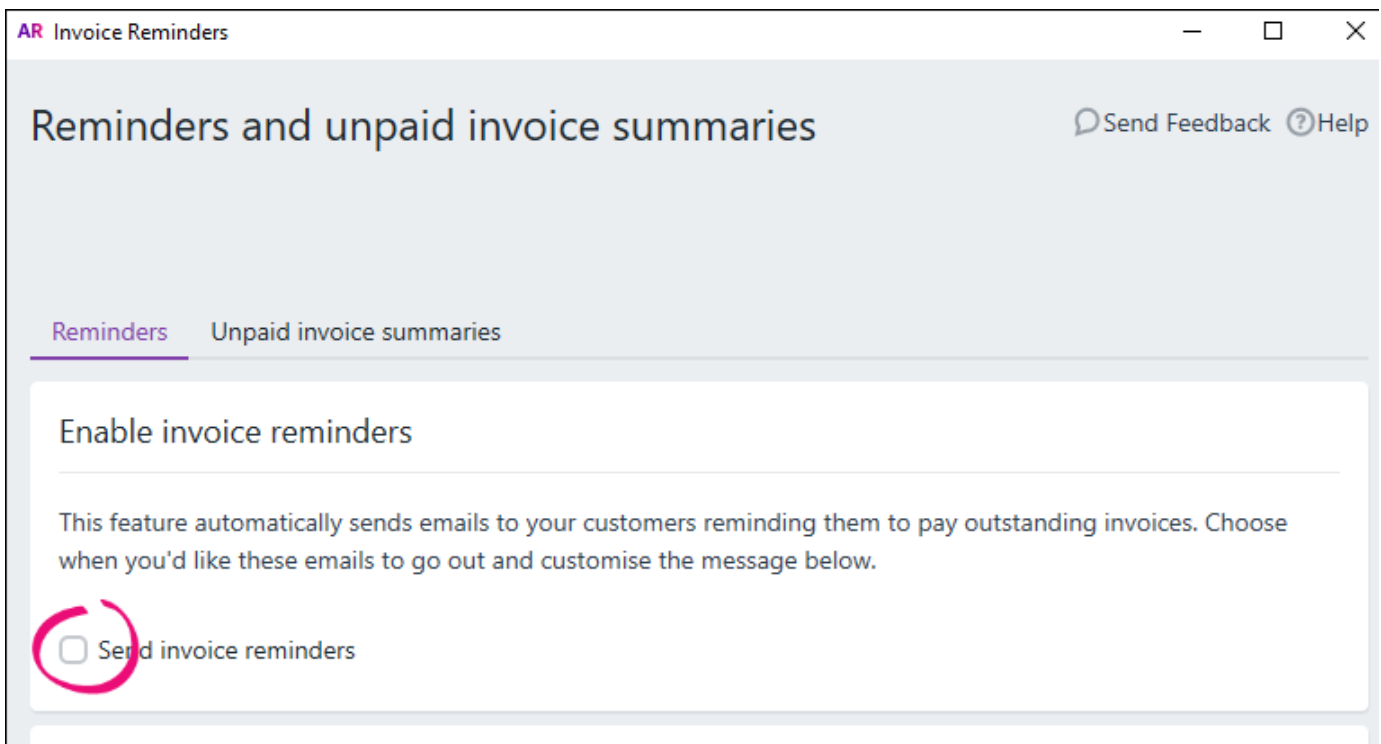


Turning off invoice reminders
